- Phenotyping (in-field, lab-based, or algae-focused)
- Stress adaptation, immunity, and epigenetics
- Plant and algal biotechnology
- Functional genomics and omics data analysis
- ── Industry-relevant R&D and innovation
- Transferable skills (e.g. communication, data management)
- Novel approaches in teaching and public engagement

We are also open to creative and cross-disciplinary workshop proposals.
